

Policy VI.6000.D, Awarding Honorary Degrees

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to define the parameters through which San Jacinto College will award honorary degrees.

Policy

It is the policy of San Jacinto College that honorary degrees may be awarded to honor enduring, outstanding service to the College or its constituent communities or to recognize superlative professional achievement in disciplines or fields served by the College's educational programs. The College's goal is to inspire past, present, and future students, faculty, staff, administrators, alumni and members of the community by recognizing individuals who embody the College's values of integrity, inclusivity, collaboration, innovation, accountability, sense of community, and excellence.

The Authority, Applicability, Sanctions, Exclusions, and Interpretation do not differ from Policy II.2000.A, Policy and Procedures Development, Review, Revision, and Rescission.
