SAN JACINTO COLLEGE IS THE GULF COAST REGION'S LEADER IN HIGHER EDUCATION

- Awarded more than 7,000 degrees and certificates in each of the last five years, including 7,135 in 2019-20 (fall 2020 certified data)
- The eighth largest community college in Texas and third largest in the Houston area
- Industry partnerships develop programs and facilities to best suit the employment pipeline in the Gulf Coast region.
- The Maritime Technology and Training Center was recognized as a 2021 Center of Excellence for Domestic Maritime Workforce Training and Education (CoE) designee by the U.S. Department of Transportation, Maritime Administration.
- The San Jac Promise program provides eligible graduates from Sam Rayburn High School, South Houston High School, and Dobie High School with up to three years of guaranteed tuition and additional assistance to earn their degree or certificate.
- Currently managing 48 grants totaling approximately \$35.8 million for workforce training, STEM, scholarships, and more
- Ranked seventh in the nation for Hispanic student enrollment (Hispanic Outlook Magazine, February 2021)
- In 2020, record-setting dual credit and early college high school programs helped more than 6,900 students work toward receiving their associate degrees before earning a high school diploma.

TRANSFERS TO FOUR-YEAR INSTITUTIONS

(Fall 2019–Summer 2020)

- The **EDGE Center** at San Jacinto College, located at the Houston Spaceport, serves as the education partner for the growing list of aerospace companies relocating to Houston.
- San Jacinto College is one of 13 higher education institutions and one of two community colleges in the U.S. to receive a **NASA MUREP Aerospace Academy grant**, which recruits and retains underserved students into science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) fields.

- More than 4,000 people annually receive **short-term technical training** through the continuing and professional development division.
- In November 2020, the **Aspen Institute College Excellence Program** and the **Siemens Foundation** named 14 San Jacinto College students as **Siemens Technical Scholars**.
- San Jacinto College is **accredited** by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges.

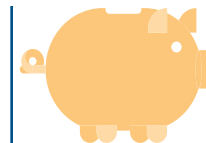
